



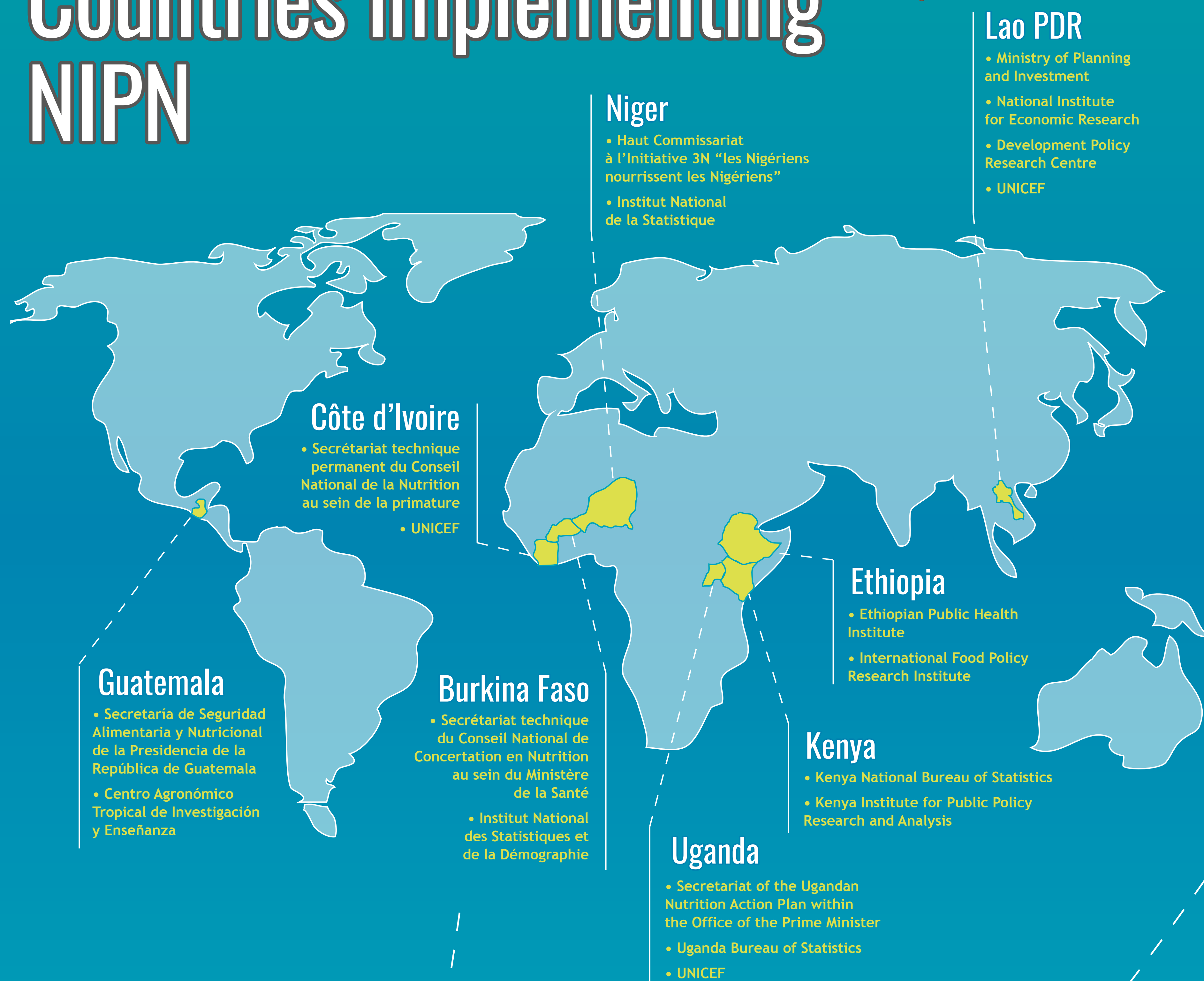

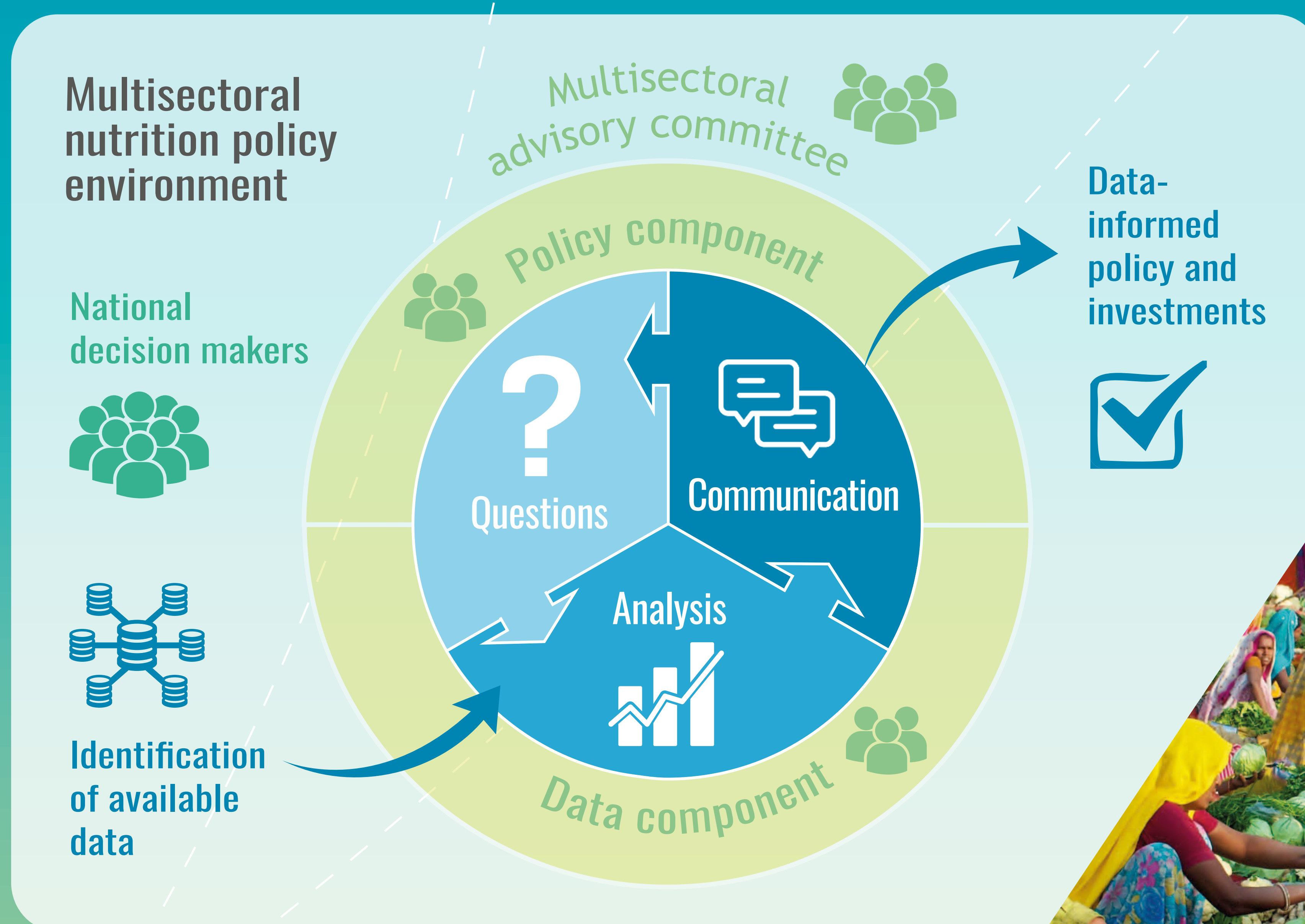


National Information Platforms for Nutrition (NIPN) is an initiative of the European Commission to provide support to countries to strengthen their information systems for nutrition and to improve the analysis of data so as to better inform the strategic decisions they are faced with to prevent malnutrition and its consequences.

NIPN GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Country-owned: Technical execution (data and analysis) and multisectoral policy steer components of the platforms are embedded within national structures

Sensitive to context: Analysis generation and findings support each country's needs and priorities in line with national nutrition agenda

Builds upon what exists: Makes the best use of current information systems and existing multisectoral nutrition coordination mechanisms

Strengthens capacities: Supports the skills, means and analytical methods to achieve objectives, at individual, organisational and systemic levels

Adds value: Complements or is synergistic with other initiatives, avoiding the duplication of efforts

Enhances multi-sectoral efforts: Generates evidence to understand progress in achieving national and international targets and informs national multi-sectoral policies and plans for better nutrition

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
